

## Ten Pesach Challenges

- Practise your Mah Nishtana -

- Give your bedroom a proper Pesach clean. Get rid of all those crumbs and empty food wrappers and put something in there to remind you of Spring, maybe some spring flowers or blossom.
- Have a look through your kitchen cupboards and see what Chametz needs to go. Consider taking it to your local foodbank so that someone else can enjoy it.
- Get your feather and candle ready and start searching for the Chametz and then on Friday morning get ready to burn your Chametz and say the brachah.

Before **beginning the search** for chametz, say:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה	Bâruch Atâ Adonoy,
אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם,	Eloheinu Melech hâ'olâm,
אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו	asher kidishânu bi'mitzvo'tâv,
וְצִוָּנוּ עַל בְּעוֹר חָמֵץ.	vi'tzivânu al bi'ur châmetz.

Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the universe,  
Who has sanctified us with His commandments,  
and commanded us about removing the chametz.

- Start making table decorations for your Seder Table.

Or perhaps decorate a tablecloth where you draw a scene from the story of the Exodus
